



Seasonal Truck Trap Operator Operates truck trap to collect mosquitoes and record rain data on assigned routes

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate travel time from District to first assigned route to begin trap run one hour after sunset
- Drives truck trap vehicle on assigned routes between 20 – 25 MPH to complete the collection of mosquitoes and obtain and record rain and weather data at the beginning and end of each run
- Ensures that the collection bag is installed and removed correctly at the beginning and end of each run, is closed immediately upon removal to ensure minimal loss of insects collected and that collection bag is correctly labeled and stored
- Reads the rain gauges at the beginning and the end of each route and enters rain data collected for each assigned route into MapVision on Toughbook computer at the time of collection
- Records the temperature at the beginning and end of each work shift and enters the data into MapVision on Toughbook computer
- Conducts walk around pre-trip vehicle inspection and ensures all necessary supplies and materials are present to complete the trip
- Refills truck with fuel at the end of the shift

Qualifications:

- Must be able to work a nighttime shift during a set weekly schedule (comprised of the same nights, every week) between **May 1st and October 31st**
- Must be able to read maps and follow assigned mapped routes
- Must have basic computer skills and have the ability to learn and operate internal and web based programs including entering data in databases
- Must be able to communicate effectively in English
- Must have a valid Class E driver's license and a clean driving record

The pay is **\$14.22 per hour** and a minimum guarantee of 8 hours of pay per nighttime shift. This is a seasonal, non-benefit eligible position and will not last longer than six months.
